Consistory Chronicles

September Elders / Consistory Meetings

The Consistory held its September meeting and reviewed a number of ministry and mission items within the life of the church.

- The Executive Team reported that we have cleared a necessary hurtle that moves us one step closer to reincorporation following our departure from the RCA and move toward the Alliance of Reformed Churches. The work done thus far also assists other sister churches in making this next step.
- Deacons continue to work on our financial accounting transition and related software, as well as reported that they have begun working on the budget for 2025. In addition, they continue to explore best practices for communicating the church's financial position.
- The Consistory reviewed the Nominations presented from the Congregation and will begin the process of discerning who is called to the next term of Elder or Deacon. We invite the congregation to be in prayer for those called to discern God's will of a possible calling.
- Looking ahead, the Consistory decided that this year we will have a Christmas Day service. Haven Reformed will hold a Christmas Eve service.
- The next Executive Team meeting is scheduled for Monday, October 21. The next Elders and Consistory meetings are scheduled for Monday, October 28.


